



Fun Facts about Cows


There are more than 800 different breeds of cows in the world, and approximately 98 million cows in the U.S.



Cows often sleep standing up.

Cows don't have front teeth in the upper part of their mouths.

A cow can eat up to 100 pounds per day, drink enough water to fill a small bath tub (50 to 80 gallons).




One cow will produce an average of 6.3 gallons of milk per day. That's more than 2,300 gallons per year.



Dairy farmers usually measure milk in pounds, not gallons. It takes 12 pounds of whole milk to make 1 gallon of ice cream!



Milk arrives at your local grocery store within 48 hours of leaving the farm.



Cows can walk up a flight of stairs, but very few can walk back down.


